Registration and Attendee Guidelines

Registration: To attend the Conference, please register on the <u>SEANM website</u> and select your registration type during the checkout process. Please note that a \$24 (20% off the standard registration fee) conference discount code is available for all those who join SEANM or renew their SEANM memberships early for the 2021-2022 annual cycle. Look for the discount code to be included in the receipt confirmation email you receive after your renewal is complete and payment has been made. Use this code when registering for the conference in order to receive 20% off your ticket price. If you are in the middle of a two-year SEANM membership, or are a member of a sister SEA organization (SEAoT, SEAoA, etc.), please email <u>StateDirector@SEANM.org</u> and we will send you the discount code.

Attendance and PDHs: Links to all virtual sessions will be sent via email in the days leading up to the conference to the email address you provide during registration. Each attendee can acquire up to 6.0 PDH hours from the conference. If you cannot attend one or more of the educational presentations, video recordings will be available to watch on demand when you are able – please email PPH certificates will be provided for self-reporting all sessions attended at the conclusion of the conference.

Noise and Questions: During each presentation we ask that all participants remain muted, with cameras off. Attendees are encouraged to use the chat feature to ask questions at any point during the presentation, and the presenter will answer as many questions as possible at the conclusion end of their presentation. Any remaining unanswered questions will be addressed in a follow-up email by the presenter following the conference.

Transitions and Breaks: There will be approximately 5 minutes between the educational presentations and the break-out sessions. Please feel free to grab a quick snack or drink, or go to the restroom during these times.

Break-Out Sessions: These are your opportunity to hear from our sponsors/vendors about their products and services. Each Break-Out Session will feature a 15-minute presentation by one of our conference sponsors. There will be a raffle at the end of each one for a great door prize, and you must be present to win.
